

HEARING PROCEEDINGS
Vacation of portion of Barnick's First Addition

August 9, 2005

Pursuant to proper notice, the City Council of Thief River Falls, Minnesota, conducted a public hearing at 4:55 p.m., on August 9, 2005 in the Council Chambers of City Hall.
