

**ADJOURNED COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
MnDOT/CITY COUNCIL**

November 28, 2006

Pursuant to proper notice, the City Council of Thief River Falls, Minnesota, met in adjourned session at 12:00 pm on Tuesday, November 28, 2006 in the Council Chambers. The following Councilmembers were present: Kajewski, Schmalz, Worker and Acting Mayor Carlson. Absent were: Blacklance, Cullen, and Holten. Acting Mayor Carlson chaired the meeting.

DISCUSSION

Discussion was held on the following items:

- 1) Status of 2007 traffic signal installation at Highway 32 and Greenwood Street;
- 2) Highways 1 and 59 improvements west of Brooks Avenue;
- 3) Left turn lane signage on Highway 59 north of First Street;
- 4) Audible pedestrian signals at traffic signaled intersections;
- 5) Status of sale of MnDot property at 417 Zeh Street West;
- 7) Joint Transportation Building future property boundaries;
- 8) Timing of "walk" signals near the hospital;
- 9) Angle parking downtown;
- 10) Pedestrian crossing on Highway 1 and Sherwood Avenue;
- 11) Extension of 30 mph zone past Northland Community and Technical College;
- 12) Roundabouts workshop will be held in the near future;
- 13) Underpass for Greenwood Street railroad crossing; and,
- 14) School children crossing at First Street and Spruce Avenue and need to slow traffic.

There being no further discussion, Councilmember Worker moved, being seconded by Councilmember Schmalz, to adjourn the meeting at 1:30 p.m. On vote being taken, the Chairman declared the motion unanimously carried and the meeting adjourned.
