

**ADJOURNED COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
City Council/County Commissioner Meeting**

June 5, 2006

- 6) Demolition of vacant house at Dewey Avenue and 13th Street.

RESOLUTION NO. 6-111-06: RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT OF AGREEMENT WITH MARKIT LANDFILL

The City Council indicated its support of Pennington County entering into an agreement with MarKit Landfill from January 2007 – September 2010 to provide landfill space for Pennington County's solid waste. Councilmember Worker moved, being seconded by Councilmember Cullen to support the move from the Grand Forks landfill to MarKit landfill.

On vote being taken, the resolution was unanimously passed.
