

PUBLIC HEARING
Vacation of Easement in Barnick's 1st Addition

August 8, 2006

Pursuant to proper notice, the City Council of Thief River Falls, Minnesota, conducted a public hearing at 5:00 p.m., on August 8, 2006 in the Council Chambers of City Hall. Paul Ihle, City Attorney, presented information with regard to the proposal to vacate the portion of a utility easement recorded in Book 119 of Records at Page 531 in the office of the Pennington County Recorder concerning Lots 1 through 6 inclusive of Block 1 of Barnick's 1st Addition to the City of Thief River Falls (except easement on said Lot 6 and southeasterly 60 feet of said Lot 5) in the City of Thief River Falls, Pennington County, Minnesota.

It should be noted that no objections were received by the City or by persons in attendance at the hearing.
