

ADJOURNED CITY COUNCIL MEETING
Meeting with Congressman Collin Peterson

June 2, 2010

The City Council of Thief River Falls, Minnesota, met in adjourned session at Noon on June 2, 2010 in the Council Chambers of City Hall. The following Councilmembers were present: Bendickson, Cullen, Kajewski, Lee, and Mayor Nordhagen. Councilmembers Holten, Schmalz and Erickson were absent. Mayor Nordhagen chaired the meeting.

Others present were Congressman Collin Peterson and County Commissioners Jensen, Swanson, and Tveitbakk.

DISCUSSION

Congressman Peterson thanked everyone for meeting with him. He updated the City Council and County Board on legislative activity in the US Congress including his work on the financial regulatory reform bill and the farm bill.

Other issues discussed included the need for federal funding assistance for County Ditch #1, the Greenwood Street Underpass, and the Thief River Falls Regional Airport.

Congressman Peterson informed the group that he has invited Congressman Oberstar to Thief River Falls in August. Oberstar is Chair of the Transportation Committee and in a position to help with the issues discussed.

There being no further discussion, Councilmember Bendickson moved, being seconded by Councilmember Cullen, to adjourn the meeting at 1:15 p.m. On vote being taken, the Chair declared the motion unanimously carried and the meeting adjourned until June 14, 2010.
