- Known as the “Jewel of Parks.”
- 1990 – Zehlian Club provided funding & organized a volunteer workforce to install a paverstone pathway along the river.
- 2001 – Zehlian’s provided funds to purchase a stunning 12-foot cascading fountain and (4) granite benches.
- 2001 – Revamped flowerbeds in park.
